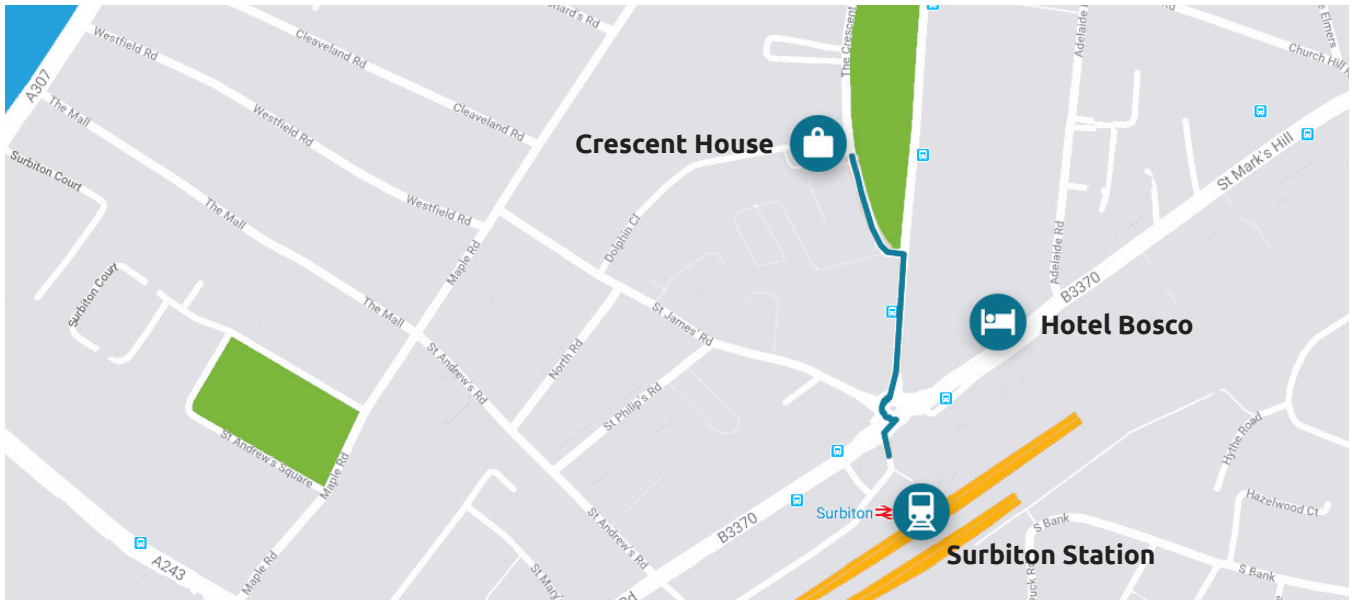


Crescent House by rail, road and air



Where is the EMA?

How do I get there by train?

South West Trains run a direct main line service from London Waterloo (Northern, Bakerloo and Jubilee lines) with 10 trains an hour off-peak (see table), and more during rush hours. Journey time is from 16 minutes. Trains also run regularly from Clapham Junction (10 minutes) and Wimbledon (District line, 7 minutes). From Victoria change at Clapham Junction.

Crescent House is two minutes' walk from the station (see map above).

What about driving?

Surbiton is 5 minutes from the A3, south west of London, and 15 minutes from Junction 10 of the M25. We have limited off-road parking at Crescent House (please call if you need parking as we have very few spaces) or there is on-road metered parking. Additionally, you can park for two hours free in Waitrose carpark nearby.

How can I get there from the airport?

Crescent House is about half an hour's drive from Heathrow and about 40 minutes from Gatwick. Station Cars (020 8390 3030) charges £30-40 for a one-way trip. Kingston Cars (020 8546 7000) is also reliable although slightly more expensive. Please let us know if you would like help booking a car from either airport.

Where can I stay?

The Bosco (hotelbosco.co.uk) is very close to Crescent House, and rates for a double room range from £100 to £130. Slightly further away, the Holiday Inn (holidayinn.com) on the Portsmouth Road overlooks the river, with rates starting at £100.
